

TIMOTHY MURPHY (director) is an internationally acclaimed entertainer whose professional career has spanned 32 years and five countries. Tim got his start as a young musical theatre performer and ventriloquist in his hometown of Sault Ste. Marie and went on to study theatre at York University and musical theatre at the prestigious Banff School of Fine Arts where he was a full scholarship recipient. As an actor and singer Mr. Murphy has performed in theatres across Canada including The National Arts
Centre in Ottawa, Winnipeg's Rainbow Stage and the historic
Winter Garden Theatre in Toronto. As a professional stage
director Timothy has helmed more than 2 dozen productions including musicals, dramas and operas. For 5 years, Mr. Murphy starred as Joan Rivers in the Las Vegas-style revue An Evening

at La Cage in Toronto, Cancun, Miami Beach and St. Maarten and as the headliner at the Sands Hotel in Puerto Rico. He was an award winner in the CBC national talent competition, DuMaurier Search for Stars and the recipient of the Queen Elizabeth Diamond Jubilee medal for his cultural contributions to the city of Sault Ste. Marie. Tim can be seen weekday mornings as the co-host of ONNtv's live local news and entertainment show, Mornings with Lou-Anne and Tim.



DAVID LINDSAY-ABAIRE (Author) is a Pulitzer Prize winning playwright, screenwriter, lyricist and librettist. His most recent play, Ripcord, opens this fall at Manhattan Theatre Club. His previous play Good People premiered on Broadway, was awarded the New York Drama Critics Circle Award for Best Play, The Horton Foote Prize, The Edgerton Foundation New American Play Award, and two Tony nominations. His play Rabbit Hole received the Pulitzer Prize for Drama, five Tony nominations, and the Spirit of America Award. David also wrote the book and lyrics for Shrek the Musical, which was nominated for eight Tonys, four Oliviers, a Grammy, and earned David the Ed Kleban Award as America's most promising musical theatre lyricist. David's other plays include Fuddy Meers, Kimberly Akimbo, Wonder of the World and A Devil Inside, among others. In addition to his work in theatre, David's screen

credits include his film adaptation of Rabbit Hole, Dreamworks' Rise of the Guardians, and the upcoming Family Fang,

ROB ASHFORD (Director, original production) won the 2012 Olivier Award for his production of Anna Christie starring Jude Law and Ruth Wilson at London's Donmar Warehouse. The production opened to rave reviews with The Independent's anointing it as "picture perfect" and David Benedict stating that "the production's hallmark is its boldness." Rob most recently directed the Broadway revival of Cat on a Hot Tin Roof starring Scarlett Johansson, and Macbeth with Sir Kenneth Branagh at New York's Park Avenue Armory and The Manchester International Festival. The Telegraph claimed "This is a Macbeth that won't just go down as a highlight of the Manchester International Festival but as one of the Scottish Play's great revivals," and Ben Brantley of the New York Times pro claimed "Mr. Ashford uses his experience as a celebrated director of musicals to stunning, time-bending effect."

Rob received his 8th Tony Nomination for his work on the Broadway revival of Evita starring Ricky Martin, and received the Tony Award for his work on the Broadway production of Thoroughly Modern Millie. Other Broadway credits include How to Succeed in Business (Tony Award Nominations for his direction and choreography), Promises, Promises (Tony Award Nomination), Shrek, John Water's Cry Baby (Tony Award nomination, Drama Desk, Outer Critics Circle, and Fred Astaire Awards), Curtains (Tony Award nomination), and Wedding Singer (Tony Award nomination). In London, Rob also directed the highly acclaimed Olivier Award winning revivals of A Streetcar Named Desire starring Rachel Weisz and Parade at The Donmar Warehouse. Rob did the choreography and staging for last year's Academy Awards with Seth MacFarlane and won the 2009 Emmy Award for Best Choreography for his work on Baz Luhrmann's production number (featuring Hugh Jackman and Beyoncé) at the 81st Annual Academy Awards. He has also choreographed the opening number for The Tony Awards starring Neil Patrick Harris for the past 4 years. He choreographed the feature film Beyond The Sea directed by and starring Academy Award winner Kevin Spacey and Walt Disney Production's upcoming film Cinderella directed by Kenneth Branagh. Most recently, Rob directed and choreographed NBC's The Sound of Music Live!, for which he received a DGA Award Nomination, and this January directed The Barber of Seville at Chicago Lyric Opera. Rob is an Associate Director at The Old Vic Theatre. He also serves on the Executive Board of The Society of Stage Directors and Choreographers and is a Trustee of The Joyce Theatre in New York City.



Transportation

We have extensive experience in all sorts of situations and are capable of hauling virtually anything ranging from materials like steet, wood, and paper to heavy machinery and aggregates. We can permit in all Provinces and Territories, as well as the United States.

Major customers include, Essar Steel and Algoma Tubes as well as many other local companies. Finished product from these mills is hauled throughout Ontario for the most part, with the occasional trips to Western Canada and the United States. Back hauls usually consist of flat bed loads, with several tractor units. Each one has a different capacity up to 80,000 lbs dedicated.

We also haul logs from the harvest areas to the mills and also have a unit dedicated to hauling trusses manufactured by Soo Mill throughout Ontario and Michigan.

Harvesting

We has always worked closely with the logging industry building the haul roads and bridges, floating the equipment and hauling the logs. In the spring of 1999 we went one step further and successfully began a full scale harvesting operation. We have harvested for companies such as Sustainable Forest Technologies, Ontario Wagner Forest Management, and Domtar. In the winter of 2016, we began harvesting on the Carp Road for Prentiss & Carisle and are presently harvesting up the Mile 38 Road. In addition, we have been contracted to provide winter maintenance on the Mile 38 Road from the highway to Batchawana Station.

Material Handling

In the summer of 2000 a new opportunity In the summer of 2000 a new opportunity arose for Avery Construction with the new owners of the Tubular Division located at Algoma Steel Inc. We negotiated a contract to handle tubular products being imported from overseas to their new facility. Our contract consists of trucking the tube rounds and finished pipe from the dock to their property. The tube rounds are delivered to the mill and the finished pipe is brought to the pipe yard where we sort according to destination. Our crew then loads the pipe on railway cars or highway tractors depending on its final destination. Although this was a big step for the company, we feel diversity is the key to success and survival in an ever changing marketplace. changing marketplace
